

First Announcement The 6th Environment and Health Summer School (EHSS) 7 – 16 July 2014 Hong Kong – Shenzhen – Zhuhai · China

Background

The Environment and Health Summer School 2014 is jointly organized by the City University of Hong Kong (CityU), Xiamen University (XMU), Peking University (PKU) and National Taiwan Ocean University (NTOU), which is to be held in Hong Kong, Shenzhen and Zhuhai from 7-16 July.

The State Key Laboratory in Marine Pollution (SKLMP), CityU and the State Key Laboratory of Marine Environmental Science (MEL) of XMU have co-organized five summer schools since 2008, which were well attended by over 440 participants from 14 countries and received very encouraging feedbacks. The Summer School series aims to provide participants the fundamental concepts, latest development and current update on the rapidly growing field of environmental science and pollution research. The course is relevant and useful for postgraduates and professional working on the areas of environmental science, pollution and public health. Limited quota is available for senior undergraduates intended to work on these research areas.

The theme of Environment and Health Summer School 2014 is on "Oceans and Human Health", which is a multidisciplinary subject of global concern. We continue our mission to provide high quality, interactive teaching and learning experiences (including lectures, field trips, student presentation and open scientific forum) to our participants. The Summer School acts as a platform to nurture young scientists via direct interaction and discussion with world-class lecturers in the field. It also provides participants a valuable opportunity for career advancement, personal enrichment and development of social awareness and responsibility to the environment.

a. Postgraduate (doctoral and master students) with limited senior undergraduate, and professionals working in the area of Ecotoxicology, Chemistry, Biology, Environmental Science, Fishery Management, Oceanic and Atmospheric Science are welcome to attend the summer school

b. The number of participants will be limited to 80, including XMU (10), SKLMP (10), PKU (10), NTOU (5), SMART (10) and other mainland universities and overseas candidates (35).

(SMART = Shenzhen Marine Research and Technology Consortium including eleven institutional members: City University of Hong Kong, Tsinghua University, Shenzhen Institutes of Advanced Technology, Chinese Academy of Science, Xiamen University, Shenzhen University, Peking University, Sun Yat-Sen University, Central South University, Nanjing University, Hong Kong Baptist University, Huazhong University of Science and Technology)

Credits and Awards

- A certificate of completion will be awarded to participants who have successfully completed the summer school.
- The Summer Course is a one- to two- credit unit postgraduate course.
 - To obtain 1 credit unit, postgraduate students are required to attend the Summer Course, submit course exercise, and give a poster presentation (in Hong Kong) and a group oral presentation (in Shenzhen).
 - To obtain 2 credit units, postgraduate students are required to fulfill all requirements listed above and to write a report / review article to a special topic covered in the course.
- Best oral and poster presentations will be awarded with special prizes
 - Best group oral presentation;
 - Best poster presentation;
 - Best nature photograph.

Fees & Financial Supports

- No registration fee is charged for qualified applicants. Fees for lecture, field trips and open scientific forum will be covered by EHSS 2014.
